If you're heading into the backcountry south or east of Anchorage, the weather forecast over the next week is calling for cooler temps, some snow and light winds. Be prepared with beacon, shovel, and probe if you venture into the backcountry.

Be advised that avalanches have been reported in the Turnagain Pass area and the danger is rated as CONSIDERABLE. Get informed of current conditions at Alaska snow dot org before you venture out.
